take place at or for social service agencies and area parks. Volunteers will share the excitement, camaraderie, teambuilding, and good feelings that come with working together.

THIS YEAR, COMMUNITY CARE DAY WILL OCCUR ON FRIDAY MAY 5. COULD YOUR AGENCY OR ANY OF THOSE YOU SERVE, USE THE HELP OF SOME VOLUNTEER MANPOWER ON THAT DATE?

We would like to assign volunteers to a task that would take between 3-6 hours to complete. We can send groups ranging from two to 20 volunteers. This is your chance to be creative and think big about an idea your organization hasn't had time, manpower, or resources to complete. Last year, volunteers:



- Built shelving for Our Daily Bread pantry
- Cleaned the basement at the Holland Theatre
- Finished landscaping projects throughout the county
- Delivered meals-on-wheels
- Sorted donations for Soteria House DV Shelter
- Picked up litter with kids at Neighborhood Outreach
- Did maintenance projects at Discovery Riders
- Prepared bulk mail for United Way
- Hung posters around town for various agencies
- Prepared breakfast for Care Day volunteers
- Handyman and painting at the homeless shelter

COMMUNITY CARE DAY PROJECT PARAMETERS

- United Way of Logan County's 2017 Community Care Day will be held on FRIDAY MAY 5.
- Because of limited resources, United Way cannot respond to all project requests submitted for completion on Community Care Day. The following shall serve as guidelines to determine the feasibility of completing requested projects.
- United Way will work with existing social service providers to help distribute Project Request Forms and determine eligible recipients.
- A Community Care Day project should fit into one of the following categories:
 - 1. Provide help to a non-profit or community-based organization (do not have to be a United Way Funded Agency to qualify).
 - 2. Provide a service that enhances the quality of life for area residents (ex. Working with local government on a park improvement project.)
- Requested projects should take place in Logan County or at the site of a United Way Funded Agency (ex. If Boy Scouts requested help at their camp, which is in Clark County.)
- Requested projects should be able to be completed by the team of volunteers in a single day. Ideally, projects would take between 3-6 hours to complete.
- All projects will be completed by at least two Community Care Day volunteers. No one will be sent to a project alone.
 - Also taken into consideration will be:
 - The number of volunteers needed to complete the project.
 - The level of skill required to complete the project.
 - The availability and accessibility of materials and to complete the project.
 - The safety of volunteers.
- Funding, materials, and tools for Community Care Day projects will need to come from:
 - 1. The project recipient is asked to provide some or all of the necessary materials.
 - 2. In-kind product donations from area businesses.
 - 3. The volunteer group doing the project.
 - Volunteers are typically expected to bring typical household tools and/or supplies from home to help (rakes, shovels, garden gloves, rags, etc.).
 - Volunteer groups could choose to fund projects or bring materials if they choose to adopt a project that requires them for completion. It would be made known well in advance that this is needed at the time of project selection.
