Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is a book gifting program that mails free, high-quality, age-appropriate books to children from birth until they are 5 years of age.

Annually it costs \$25 per child to receive 12 books mailed straight to their home. This is made possible by generous donors, local educators, libraries and various community partners.
