The Logan County Department of Job & Family Services is offering a **ONE-TIME** Back-to-School clothing voucher program for school age children to purchase clothing needed for the 2016-2017 school year. If you have children who meet the following eligibility guidelines, please complete and sign the enclosed application, along with the Rules and Regulations, and return **BOTH** pages to Logan County Job & Family Services

between:

June 27, 2016 to July 15,2016.

The eligibility guidelines are:

- 1. Must be a resident of Logan County currently and at the time the voucher is issued.
- 2. Must be enrolled to attend public school or private school outside of the home.
- 3. Must be between the ages of 5-18 AND enrolled in grades K-12 during the 2016-2017 school year.

If your child receives public assistance in the form of Food Stamps, OWF or a medical card (Medicaid, Caresource, Molina, Buckeye, United Healthcare, Paramount), that may be used to determine eligibility for the program. If your child <u>does not</u> receive public assistance, income verification for 30 days prior to application date must be provided to determine eligibility. Incomplete applications or failure to provide income verification will result in denial of eligibility.

The Back-to School clothing program intends to provide \$175.00 per child in the form of a voucher which may be used only in Bellefontaine at one of the following vendors: Wal-Mart, JC Penney, Rue21, or Goodys. Be advised that <u>not</u> all vendors may carry the sizes and/or style appropriate for your child. You must indicate on your application which vendor you have chosen. That choice is final and cannot be changed. <u>Vouchers are limited to the first 1800 students meeting eligibility.</u>

Families will be able to shop at the **BELLEFONTAINE STORES ONLY** - August 12 - 28, 2016. The \$175 voucher must be used in one shopping trip. It is to your child's advantage to use the entire voucher.

Back-to-School Clothing Program Rules and Regulations THIS MUST BE SIGNED AND RETURNED WITH APPLICATION

- 1. Allowable items include:
 - Clothing: Articles of personal apparel including footwear and outerwear
- 2. Voucher must be used **ONLY** at the **BELLEFONTAINE** retail store named on the voucher for the child listed on the voucher by the expiration date on the voucher.
- 3. There are **NO** monetary refunds allowed for items purchased with the voucher. The **ONLY** allowable exchange will be for correct clothing size or manufacturer defect. **NO OTHER EXCHANGES ARE ACCEPTABLE.**
- 4. Shopping dates are <u>August 12- August 28, 2016</u>. All items must be purchased together at the same time. Any remaining amount not spent is forfeited. Any amount over the voucher limit is your responsibility to pay. Be advised that tax **may not be** charged for items purchased with the voucher, but **may be** charged on any amount that is your responsibility to pay.
- 5. You are required to provide ID and signature on both the voucher and sales receipt. Be advised that sales receipts are returned to Job & Family Services.
- 6. Only **ONE** voucher will be issued per child. Vouchers are **NOT** replaced if lost, stolen or destroyed.
- 7. If you have any problems or concerns with the use of this program, you may contact JFS at 937-599-5165. The stores do not make the rules for the use of the vouchers.

I certify that I will comply with all the rules and regulations as stated above. I understand that the law provides a penalty of fine and/or imprisonment for anyone convicted of accepting assistance for which he/she is not eligible. I give the retailer, with whom I have selected to fulfill my purchase, my consent to contact Logan County Job & Family Services as necessary, to determine my eligibility with regards to this program.

HOW TO OBTAIN AN OHIO ABSENTEE BALLOT

You are entitled to vote by absentee ballot in Ohio without providing a reason. Absentee ballot applications may be obtained from your county board of elections or from the Secretary of State at: www.OhioSecretaryofState.gov or by calling (877) 767-6446.

OHIO VOTER IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Voters must bring identification to the polls in order to verify identity. Identification may include current and valid photo identification, a military identification, or a copy of a current (within the last 12 months) utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document (other than a notice of voter registration mailed by a board of elections) that shows the voter's name and current address. Voters who do not provide one of these documents will still be able to vote by providing the last four digits of the voter's Social Security number and by casting a provisional ballot pursuant to R.C. 3505.181. Eligibility

You are qualified to register to vote in Ohio if you meet all the following requirements:

- 1. You are a citizen of the United States.
- You will be at least 18 years old on or before the day of the general election.
- 3. You will be a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days immediately before the election in which you want to vote.
- 4. You are not incarcerated (in jail or in prison) for a felony conviction.
- You have not been declared incompetent for voting purposes by a probate court.
- You have not been permanently disenfranchised for violations of election laws.

Use this form to register to vote or to update your current Ohio registration if you have changed your address or name.

NOTICE: This form must be *received or postmarked* by the 30th day before an election at which you intend to vote. You will be notified by your county board of elections of the location where you vote. If you do not receive a notice following timely submission of this form, please contact your county board of elections.

Numbers 1 and 2 below are required by law. You *must* answer *both* of the questions for your registration to be processed.

Registering in Person

If you have a current valid Ohio driver's license, you must provide that number on line 10. If you do not have an Ohio driver's license, you must provide the *last four digits* of your Social Security number on line 10. If you have neither, please write "None."

Please see information on back of this form to learn how to obtain an absentee ballot.

Registering by Mail

If you register by mail and do not provide either an Ohio driver's license number or the last four digits of your Social Security number, you must enclose with your application a copy of one of the following forms of identification:

Current and valid photo identification, a military identification, or a current (within the last 12 months) utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or government document (other than a notice of voter registration mailed by a board of elections) that shows the voter's name and current address.

Residency Requirements

Your voting residence is the location that you consider to be a permanent, not a temporary, residence. Your voting residence is the place in which your habitation is fixed and to which, whenever you are absent, you intend to return. If you do not have a fixed place of habitation, but you are a consistent or regular inhabitant of a shelter or other location to which you intend to return, you may use that shelter or other location as your residence for purposes of registering to vote. If you have questions about your specific residency circumstances, you may contact your local board of elections for further information.
